Candidates must read the instructions carefully mentioned on the Admit Card and ensure strict compliance during the examination process.

Instructions for the Trade Test:

- 1. Candidates must report at the venue on the **Reporting date and time**, specified in the Admit Cards.
- 2. Candidates must bring originals of the following certificates / documents along with the self-attested copies thereof at the time of Trade Test failing which they will not be allowed to appear in Trade Test:
 - o Matriculation or equivalent certificate as proof of date of birth;
 - o Certificates in support of educational qualifications;
 - o Experience certificate(s), wherever applicable;
 - Caste / EWS certificate (if applicable) in the prescribed format of Government of India issued by the competent authority;
 - o No Objection Certificate (NOC) if currently employed in Government/PSU;
 - One recent passport-size colour photograph (preferably the same as uploaded with the application);
 - Valid Photo ID proof issued by Central/State Government;
 - o Any other relevant certificate supporting the claim made in the application.

3. General Guidelines:

- No TA/DA will be paid for attending the Trade Test.
- Smoking, chewing tobacco or any intoxicants are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall.
- o Candidates must follow all instructions provided by the Invigilators or Examination Officials. Misconduct of any kind shall lead to expulsion and disqualification.
- No request for change in time, date, or examination centre will be entertained under any circumstances.
- Use of electronic gadgets such as mobile phones, smart watches, Bluetooth devices, cameras, etc. is strictly prohibited. Possession of such devices may lead to disqualification.
- o Candidates are advised to be available for the entire duration of the Trade Test on the given date.
