General Instructions

(For identification and authentication of Plants, Algae and Lichen specimens)

- 1. The specimens will be accepted only along with duly filled Requisition Form. (The Requisition Form can be downloaded from CSIR-NBRI website: www.nbri.res.in)
- 2. The samples should be provided in duplicates in good condition along with flowers/fruits/cones/reproductive structures. Vegetative samples/seedlings will not be entertained.
- 3. The algal specimens should be sent in 4^oC or in agar slant or live culture and the type of the habitat will be mentioned clearly.
- 4. The live samples or unmounted dried samples are required for authentication and the same will be accessioned in LWG herbarium for future reference.
- 5. The authentication charges are as follow:
 - I. Category 1. Students/Research Scholars/Scientists/Academicians/ Research or Academic or Other Institutions: Rs. 1000+18%GST
 - II. Category 2: Industries: Rs. 5000 +18%GST
- 6. The requisition forms can be submitted along with samples in person or by post/courier.
- 7. Samples received in good condition only will be examined. If the specimens received are imperfect or damaged, the applicant will be informed for replacement and resubmission of the specimens.
- 8. The authentication charges will be informed to the applicant after preliminary examination. The Authentication Certificate will be sent after submitting the transaction details of full payment.
- 9. The applicant under Category-I should submit a letter of recommendation from his or her Supervisor/ Head of the Department along with the requisition form.
- 10. Time needed for analysis will depend on the number of samples and complexity of the specimens.
